Cllr K Bonsor advised that a resident had offered to fund the flowers in the village and that a complaint had been received regarding aircraft over the village. This will be an agenda item for September. Cllr K Bonsor also advised that a surveyor would be attending site regarding the telecoms box at Spring Close.
