



Introducing Proposals for St Clere's Solar Farm

September 2020



- To the west of Danbury
- Will generate approximately 25 megawatts (MW) of clean renewable electricity.
- Supply clean power directly into the local network.
- Sensitive to existing arable land bounded by mature trees and hedgerows, for the most part, with a substantial wooded area to the north.
- Situated on 35 hectares of lower grade agricultural land (grade 3b and grade 4).

Timescales

- A Planning Pre-application request was submitted for the solar farm in September 2019.
- We have recently submitted an EIA Screening Opinion Request.
- A wide range of environmental subjects will be taken into consideration including traffic impacts, landscape and visual impacts and ecology.
- Currently hoping to submit our planning application later this year, after we have had the opportunity to make any project refinements after the community consultation.
